On the intensification of the measures
to prevent the infection with
new coronavirus tip (COVID-19)

Based on the Decision no. 6 of the National Extraordinary Commission on Public Health, taken during the working session of 10.03.2020, of the Order of the Minister of Education, Culture and Research no. 292 of 10.03.2020, the Directive of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Research no. 04 / 1-09 / 1666 of 11.03.2020, Order of the rector no. 51-A of 09.03.2020 regarding the intensification of the prophylaxis measures of the infection with new type Coronavirus (COVID-19) in order to ensure the health, protection of life and health of the beneficiaries of studies and the University employees, following the evolution of the epidemiological situation and the measures taken by the authorities to prevent the spread of the epidemic of COVID-19 virus in the country,

ORDER:

1. To apply the activity at home (working from distance) for all University staff, mainly for people aged 60, pregnant women and women with children up to 10 years! Responsible: vice-rectors, heads of subdivisions.
2. To prohibit access to all teaching blocks and university buildings. Responsible: M. Abraș, Vice-Rector for Social Activity; Valentina Șpac, Head of the Department of Heritage Administration.
3. To draw up a work program for ensuring the continuity of the activity processes of the university subdivisions located in the central academic building of the University by the presence of the minimum necessary staff at the workplace. Responsible: vice-rectors, deans, heads of subdivisions.
4. To organize the activity of the theoretical and preclinical chairs from a distance (at home) in order to develop the online courses (deadline 30 March 2020). Responsible: Olga Cernetchi, first vice-rector, vice-rector for didactic activity; Silvia Stratulat, Head of the Department of Didactics and Academic Management, deans, heads of departments /chairs/disciplines.
5. To carry out the activity of the clinical chairs, by drawing up a work program with the appointment of the persons responsible for ensuring the clinical activity within the clinical bases of the University. Responsible: heads of clinical chairs; V. Revenco, Vice-Rector for Clinical Activity and Residency; Sergiu Pisarenco, senior methodist, Clinical Activity Management Center.
6. To ensure the activity of the residents strictly in the medical institutions, where they are employed according to the order of the Ministry of Health, Labor and Social Protection. To organize the related cycles between March 16 - 27, 2020. Responsible: V. Revenco, Vice-Rector for Clinical Activity and Residency; L. Grib, Dean of Faculty of Residency, heads of departments/chairs/clinics.
7. To organize continuing medical training courses on-line. Responsible: Olga Cernetchi, First Vice-Rector, Vice-Rector for Didactic Activity; V. Badan, Head of the Department of Continuing Medical Education, heads of university subdivisions.
8. To ensure the collaboration of representatives of the Department of Epidemiology with the National Agency for Public Health. Responsible: Gh. Placinta, Dean of Faculty of Medicine no. 1, Angela Paraschiv, Head of Department of Epidemiology.

9. To suspend the activity of the University Food Complex (canteens and buffets) until 31.03.2020. Responsible: M. Abras, Vice-Rector for Social Activity; Rodica Iachim, Head of the University Food Complex.
10. To ensure the activity of the Transport Service in the ordinary regime. Responsible: A. Cigolea, Head of the Transport Service.
11. To assess daily the epidemiological situation in the Student Campus. Responsible: V. Revenco, Vice-Rector for Clinical Activity and Residency; M. Abras, Vice-Rector for Social Activity; L. Grib, Dean of Faculty of Residency; M. Betiu, Dean of Faculty of Medicine no. 2; I. Cemortan, Head of the Department of Recruitment and Documentation of Foreign Citizens.
12. To provide medical assistance to students and residents, at addressing, in the provisional medical unit, opened in the Center of Traditional Chinese Medicine. Responsible: V. Revenco, Vice-Rector for Clinical Activity and Residency; Angela Tomacinschi, PHI Chief doctor, University Clinic of Primary Medical Assistance of *Nicolae Testemitanu* SUMPh; Lilia Lupu, head of the students / residents health unit of *Nicolae Testemitanu* SUMPh; Gh. Curocichin, Head of the Department of Family Medicine.
13. To organize individual and on-line sessions of psychological counseling of the students and employees of the University, especially of the international students staying in hostels. Responsible: M. Abras, Vice-Rector for Social Activity; deans; I. Cemortan, Head of the Department of Recruitment and Documentation of Foreign Citizens; Mariana Cernitanu, Head of the Center for Psychological Counseling and Career Guidance; social educators.
14. To restrict the access of strangers to hostels and students' exits in public spaces except pharmacies and food marketing units. Responsible: M. Abras, Vice-Rector for Social Activity, V. Schiopu, Head of Student Campus, hostels administrators.
15. To create a group of student-volunteers, who will organize, if necessary, various volunteering activities. Responsible: M. Abras, Vice-Rector for Social Activity, Gh. Buruiana, President of Association of Students and Residents in Medicine.
16. To ensure the continuity of the activity in the medical healthcare institutions of the University students employed in the field of work, according to the provisions of the individual employment contracts. Responsible: V. Revenco, Vice-Rector for Clinical Activity and Residency.
17. To reschedule the conduct of the "MedEspera 2020" Students and Young Doctors' Congress for October this year. Responsible: St. Groppa, Vice-Rector for Research, M. Abras, Vice-Rector for Social Activity, Gh. Buruiana, President of Association of Students and Residents in Medicine.
18. To ensure the internal communication with the University employees through the e-mail addresses of institutional type (name.prenume@usmf.md), with the students through the University Management Information System and the university information portal (<https://usmf.md>). Responsible: Silvia Ciubrei, Head of the Department of Communication and Public Relations; deans.
19. To check daily the individual e-mail address (firstname.lastname@usmf.md) and the university information portal (<https://usmf.md>) for information and documentation purposes, to be receptive to telephone calls. Responsible: all University employees.
20. To disseminate this order within the university community. Responsible: Silvia Ciubrei, Head of the Department of Communication and Public Relations.
