On the prophylaxis measures
of the new type Coronavirus infection
(COVID-19)

According to the provisions of the Decision of the National Extraordinary Public Health Commission no. 1 of February 2, 2020, regarding the epidemiological situation of the new type Coronavirus infection, of the decision of the World Health Organization to declare a public health emergency of international interest, the Order of the Minister of Health, Labor and Social Protection no. 81 of 24.01.2020 regarding the measures of prevention and control of the new type Coronavirus infection (COVID-19), the Order of the Minister of Education, Culture and Research no. 174 of 25.02.2020 regarding the epidemiological prophylaxis of influenza, acute respiratory infections and the new type Coronavirus infection (2019-nCoV) in educational institutions, the directive of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Research no. 03 / 1-09 / 1044 of 19.02.2020, in order to ensure the health and life safety of the beneficiaries of studies and of the University employees,

ORDER:

1. To ensure periodic information of students, doctoral students and resident-doctors on the prevention measures, clinical manifestations and early diagnosis of the new type Coronavirus infection (COVID-19) according to Annex no.1 to this order, with the recommendation of detention at home in case of manifestation of symptoms of respiratory disorders and immediate address to the family doctor. Persons in charge: deans of faculties and heads of teaching subdivisions.
2. To prohibit the conducting of job activities of the university staff who have symptoms of influenza or acute respiratory infections, with the recommendation of being detained at home in case of manifestation of symptoms (cough, fever) and immediate address to the family doctor.
3. To restrict the movement abroad of the country in the areas affected by the new type Coronavirus infection (COVID-19) of the university staff and of the students assuming full responsibility by the persons who move on their own initiative.
4. Recommend to people who have traveled abroad at return to self-monitor the health status for a period of 14 days, and at the onset of the clinical symptoms of acute respiratory infection to contact the family doctor.
5. To ensure the cleaning of the study rooms at the university departments by ventilating the rooms, processing the surfaces with disinfectant substances, as well as observing the study schedule and the working regime. Persons in charge: heads of departments and university subdivisions.
6. To ensure the emergency purchase of disinfectants for hands and surfaces, as well as liquid soap and disposable paper towels, according to the requirements established for complying with the sanitary-epidemic rules for the prevention of infection with the new type Coronavirus infection (COVID-19). In charge: Victoria Cravet, Vice-Rector for Economic-Financial Activity; Snejana Balan, Head of Purchase and Marketing Department.
7. To ensure the endowment of the academic buildings, of the university clinics and of the hostels with disinfectants for hands, as well as with liquid soap and paper towels for single use at the entrances of buildings and sanitary blocks. In charge: Valentina Spac, Head of Assets Administration Department; buildings and hostels administrators).

8. To ensure the arrangement of isolation wards for students in hostels no. 13 and 17 in case of occurrence of cases of infection with the new type Coronavirus infection (COVID-19) and limit the contact with the suspect / sick person. In charge: M. Abras, Vice-Rector for Social Activity; V. Schiopu, Head of the Student Campus; A. Garbuz, senior methodist, Clinical Activity Management Center.
9. To ensure the monitoring of the foreign students who come to study at the University and their temporary accommodation, for a period of 14 days, in the spaces of hostel no. 17, isolated from the other students. In charge: V. Schiopu, Head of the Student Campus; A. Garbuz, senior methodist, Clinical Activity Management Center; hostels administrators.
10. To inform the Bureau of Migration and Asylum of the Ministry of Internal Affairs regarding the measures of prevention of the new type Coronavirus infection (COVID -19) undertaken within the institution and the need to extend the term of documentation of foreign citizens coming to university studies. In charge: I. Cemortan, Head of Recruitment and Documentation of Foreign Citizens Department.
11. To ensure the triage and the provision of the necessary medical assistance to the suspects / patients among the students and employees of the University (as the case may be). In charge: Angela Tomacinschi, Head physician of PHI University Clinic of Primary Medical Care of *Nicolae Testemitanu* SUMPh; Lilia Lupu, Head of the Students/Residents Health Unit of *Nicolae Testemitanu* SUMPh; Gh. Curocichin, Head of Family Medicine Department.
12. To ensure the provision of methodological consultative aid to healthcare institutions on the principles of the provision of medical assistance, the measures of prevention and response to the new type Coronavirus infection (COVID-19) by the specialized doctors, employees of the University. In charge: V. Revenco, Vice-Rector for Clinical Activity and Residence; Sergiu Pisarenco, Clinical Activity Management Center.
13. To ensure the intensification of the wet scrubbing regime of surfaces, handles and doors at least 2 times a day and as necessary, with authorized disinfectant solutions, as well as frequent ventilation of the rooms (in charge: Valentina Spac, Head of Assests Management Department; academic building, university clinics and hostels) and monitoring of the correct and periodic carrying out of the activities mentioned by A. Garbuz, senior methodist, Clinical Activity Management Center.
14. To ensure hygienic conditions and healthy nutrition of students and employees in university canteens and buffets, a menu rich in fruits and vegetables. In charge: Rodica Iachim, Head of the University Food Complex.
15. To ensure permanent monitoring and immediate information of the University Rector about the occurrence of cases of infection with the new type Coronavirus infection (COVID -19). In charge: A. Garbuz, senior methodist, Clinical Activity Management Center.
16. To ensure the dissemination of the present order within the university community with the mentioning in the minutes and to inform the staff in the meetings organized in subdivisions, against signature. In charge: Silvia Ciubrei, Head of Communication and Public Relations Department, deans of faculties, heads of university subdivisions.
17. Control of the execution of this order is assigned to Mr. Valeriu Revenco, Vice-Rector for Clinical Activity and Residency.

1. Severe acute respiratory infection (SARI) in a person with a history of fever, cough requiring hospitalization, and no other etiology of the disease, which fully explains the clinical manifestations (consideration will be given to the possibility of atypical manifestation of the disease at patients with immunodeficiency);

And any of the following circumstances:

- a. travel history or person who has lived in Wuhan, Hubei Province China for the last 14 days until the onset of symptoms; or
 - b. the disease occurred in a medical worker who provided medical assistance / care to patients with severe acute respiratory infections, disregarding place of residence or travel history.
2. The person who develops an unusual or unexpected clinical picture, especially with a sudden unfavorable evolution despite the appropriate treatment, not taking into account the place of residence or travel history, even if another etiology of the disease fully explaining the clinical manifestations has been identified.
3. 3. A person with acute respiratory disease of any severity who, during the 14 days until the onset of the disease, had any of the following exposures:
 - a. close contact with a confirmed case of infection with the new type Coronavirus infection (COVID -19); or
 - b. being in a medical unit in a country where infections with the new type Coronavirus infection (COVID -19) associated with the provision of healthcare have been reported; or
 - c. visiting or performing work on a live animal market in Wuhan, China.
